Molly now Scarlet Jo, JoJo or Punkin is now living the good life because of you.

This is Molly the day she arrived at Portage APL. It was below freezing that day. Her leg was badly hurt; she had wounds on her face, her bones were sticking out and she was scared of everything and everyone. We originally thought she had been hit by a car or in some accident. After further examination and time, it was clear that

she suffered from neglect and abuse. Her leg injury was new but the many other wounds and scars were not. She was also very thin and hungry.

She had a long road ahead which became more clear as time went on. Her leg took much longer to heal than expected and never did heal completely. She gained much needed weight and trust. A couple months into her recovery, we noticed a small tumor on her tummy. It was removed and sent for biopsy which revealed cancer. They removed all of the tumor but there was a chance others may return later. This poor girl was now a "special needs" dog and we would need to find a family that would love her despite her health issues.



She had grown into a sweet, loving, friendly dog with a limp. Her eyes were now trusting and she loved people. She no longer cowered or tried to hide. She may have been "special needs" but we knew she was just plain special! One day a family came to meet her and as

they say, "the rest was history." They loved her and she felt the same. We can

only guess how terrible her life may have been before but we hope her new life has helped her forget the past. It's hard to believe she is the same dog.

Her family says: 'If you remember, she is a special needs gal. We love her. She is a sun worshipper, loves the outdoors, loves her sister WinnyFred, loves my son's dog-Frank, and loves to hang out in the backyard by the blueberry bushes. She has adjusted quite well and will always hold a place in our hearts."

Spay and Neuter Services for Cats

Low cost spay and neuter services are a very important part of helping stop pet overpopulation and unwanted animals entering shelters or being euthanized. At Portage APL, we work hard to do our part. Although we don't have our own clinic, we do host a mobile clinic that comes to our location to offer these services. We use **N.O.M.A.D.** who offers a variety of services. Every animal adopted from the APL is spayed or neutered. Please call us to schedule an appointment. We offer one or two clinics each month. We also sell Friends of Animals certificates (for cats and dogs) that can be used at many local veterinarians. We also have humane traps that people can borrow to trap stray or feral cats to bring in to be spayed or neutered.

Behind the scenes, there is so much more happening between shelters than people know or realize. We communicate, collaborate and do the most we can to help animals in our communities. We know each other by first names and talk regularly. We may not draw attention to it often but it happens a lot. We are grateful to have such good relationships and partners. It's all about the animals.
